



## The Leaders Journey



You will work with children and adults in schools and social enterprises near Nairobi, Kenya. You will be challenged to make a difference each day in an intensive week. You will meet inspirational leaders working in difficult conditions. The environment that supports any limiting beliefs about yourself and others will have disappeared: how will you lead?

You will teach pupils, support teachers, and mentor local micro-entrepreneurs. You will work in a small group of a half-a-dozen leaders, supported by experienced facilitators. You will be inspired by local leaders and by your vision of what you could do here. You will be challenged to develop a project. What difference will you make?

You will review your work and give and get feedback from other Global Leaders. There will be time to reflect and get coaching. This journey can help you take your leadership to another level.

We usually stay at the Wildebeest Eco-Camp, <http://wildebeestecocamp.com/> just south of Nairobi, and work at the Kibera Girls Soccer Academy, in Kibera, a massive slum area, where we are helping establish a Business Academy mentoring would-be entrepreneurs, and local social enterprises. We also visit Kibiko School, in a rural setting near Ngong, 30 minutes west of Nairobi, where we completed a borehole. WellBoring, a charity that grew out of the Journeys, has provided wells for 27 schools. We also visit social enterprises like

The Journeys run for a week, usually in the third week of January, the second week of June and the first week of October, subject to availability; flying into Nairobi on the Saturday, and completing the Journey the following Friday evening, with options to stay on independently. We've been running the Journeys since 2009 and take safety very seriously.

The investment in your development is £4,250 including coaching, accommodation, meals, in-country transport, and contributions to our local hosts. It does not include flights.
